Prerequisites

1. **A copy of driver's license or other proof of residency (i.e. utility bill)**
(New residents may provide a copy of lease or utility bill for proof of residence.)

MN Driver's License # if applying by mail _____

2. **Complete application including full name and date of birth.**
3. **Permit must be placed in window where visible from the exterior.**
4. **Permit is valid through the expiration date.**
5. **This permit excludes permit holder from Dayton City Ordinance 701.04 subd. 2 only. Permit holder must abide by all other sections of the Dayton City Ordinance 701, County Ordinances and MN State Statutes.**

City of Dayton Parking Permit Information

- The purpose of the permit is for police to know if the car belongs to a resident of the area or their guest.
- Permits are issued to the home address, not the vehicle. This allows the permit to be placed in a visitor's vehicle if they need to park overnight.
- Permits should be hung from the backside of the mirror.
- Permits are valid for one year.
- Permits only provide an exception for the no parking from 2:00am - 6:00am parking rule. All other parking rules and statutes must be obeyed.



- In the case of a snow event all vehicles must be off the roadway for snowplows to get through.
- Vehicle must be “roadworthy” meaning current registration, all required equipment, operable, etc.
 - Must park along your own property line.
 - Must not block neighbor’s driveway or mailbox.
 - Permits are not valid on commercial vehicles.
